

## SEVERE WEATHER

### Please keep in a safe place for reference

Dear Parents and Carers,

As the winter months progress and the weather turns colder and forecasters mention snowfalls, please find below the instructions for what to do if the school needs to close due to severe weather conditions. Obviously I will always try to keep the school open if at all possible. Only myself, Mrs Barry, Mrs Fisher and Mrs Bryer live in the Street area so are able to walk to work. All the other teaching, support and admin staff live at least ten miles from Walton, mostly in rural village locations. This makes it very difficult for them to drive to work. I am also unable to open the school if the site is too icy or the heating fails or pipes freeze so we have no toilets.
